In the Name of God Amen I Ann Woodward of Lighthorn in the County of Warwick Widow being in good health of body and of Sound and Disposing Mind Memory and Understanding (praised be God for the same) But calling to mind the Uncertainty of this Life and Seriously Considering the Certainty of Death Do make and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament in Manner following (that is to say) Imprimis

I give and bequeath unto my three grand children Thomas Green, John Green and Robert Green the sum of one guinea a piece to be paid to them Respectively by my executors herein after Named out of my Personal Estate within six Calendar months next after my Decease ALSO I give and bequeath unto my Grand daughter Rose Green All my Clothes and Wearing apparel whatsoever AND as to all my goods Chattels and Implements of Household Furniture Money Securities for Money Plate and all the rest Residue and Remainders of my Personal Estate whatsoever and wheresoever I hereby give and bequeath unto my two sons William Green of Lighthorne aforesaid Clerk and Robert Green of Combrook in the said County of Warwick Grazier to be Equally Divided between them share and share alike They thereout paying all my Just debts Funeral Expencies and Charges of Proving this my Last Will and Testament hereby Revoking all former wills by me at any Time heretofore made
