W.C.R.O. Will of John Greneway of Lighthorne 1557

In the Name of God Amen. A.D. 1557. The 27th day of May, I John Greneway of Lighthorne husbandman being sick in body but of good & perfect mind make this my Last Will and Testament as followeth.

First I bequeath my soul to almighty god unto our blessed lady and to all the company of heaven and my body to be buried in the church yard of Lighthorne.

Also I bequeath to the mother church of Worcester 2d.

To the church of Lighthorne 4d.

To Richard my son £3 at the age of eighteen years.

To Elnor my daughter 40s. at the age of eighteen years, and them to be heirs to the other. The residue of my goods both movable & unmovable my debts paid and my body brought to the earth I bequeath to Agnes my wife whom I make my sole executrix.

Also I ordain John Randoll & John Suffolk to be supervisors to see this my last will & testament truly performed. To this witness John Knight & William Harbart with others Proved etc, at Stratford before Master Hall 28th day August 1557.
