In the Name of God Amen. A.D. 1557. The 27th day of May, I Juliana Wylkyns of Lighthorne widow being sick in body but of good & perfect mind make this my Last Will and Testament as followeth. First I bequeath my soul to almighty god unto our blessed lady and to all the company of heaven and my body to be buried in the church yard of Lighthorne. Also I bequeath to the mother church of Worcester 2d. To the church of Lighthorne 4d.

To Richard Greneway 10s.

To Elnor Greneway 5s.

To every godchild that I have 2d. To Ellyn Spicer 12d.

To Richard Reve of Stratford 2 strikes of wheat & 2 strikes of Barley.

The residue of my goods both movable & unmovable, my debts being paid & my body honestly brought on earth I give to John Greneway whom I make my sole executor. Also I ordain John Randoll & John Suffolk to be supervisors to see this my Last Will and Testament truly performed.

To this witness John Knight William Harbart with others.
