

W.C.R.O. Will of Leonard Jeacocks of Lighthorne 1708.

September the twenty second A.D.1708, I Leonard Jeacocks of Lighthorne in the County of Warwick yeoman make my Last Will and Testament as followeth .

First I give to my sister **Judith** forty pounds to be paid two years after my decease.

Item I give to my son **William** twenty shillings.

Item I give to my son **John** twenty shillings.

Item I give to my son **Thomas** twenty shillings.

Item I give to my son in law **Alexander Nichols** twenty shillings.

Item I give to my daughter **An** twenty shillings.

The rest of my goods chattels and cattle of what nature or kind soever I give to my son **Richard** whom I make sole executor of this my Last Will and Testament.

Signed sealed and published in the presence of **Leonard Jecocks**(signed)

25th May 1709 In which day the executor named appeared personally before me and was duly sworn in law. **W.Worth.**
