W.C.R.O. Will of Leonard Jeacocks of Lighthorne 1708.

September the twenty second A.D.1708, I Leonard Jeacocks of Lighthorne in the County of Warwick yeoman make my Last Will and Testament as followeth .

First I give to my sister Judith forty pounds to be paid two years after my decease.

Item I give to my son William twenty shillings.

Item I give to my son John twenty shillings.

Item I give to my son Thomas twenty shillings.

Item I give to my son in law Alexander Nichols twenty shillings.

Item I give to my daughter An twenty shillings.

The rest of my goods chattels and cattle of what nature or kind soever I give to my son Richard whom I make sole executor of this my Last Will and Testament.
