W.C.R.O. Will of Margerie Grene of Ashorne 1558

In the Name of God Amen. the 28th day of August In the year of our Lord God 1558 I Margerie Grene widow of Ashorne in the county of Warwick sick in body but whole in mind make my last will & testament in manner & form following .First I bequeath my soul to almighty God,our blessed lady & all the holy company of heaven & my body to be buried in the church yard of Newbold Pacey.

Item I bequeath to my son Richard Grene one ---, a pot of a gallon & a half, 2 lands of wheat, & 2 of barley.

Item I give to my god daughter Gillian Grene a sheep.

Item I give to Henry Powers a strike of wheat & to his wife a sheep, & another sheep amongst her children. And I give also to the said wife of Henry Powers my violet kirtell & Isabel her daughter a caster of half a holl(sic).

Item I give to Jane Grene my best white petticoat.

Item I give to my god son Thomas Hakyns 8d.

Item I give to our church of Newbold a strike of wheat.

Item I give & bequeath to my 2 daughters Agnes & Margaret all my household stuff which 2 daughters I make my executors.

And I desire John Hobbins & Richard Overton to be my overseers that this my will may be performed as my trust is in them.
