

W.C.R.O. Will of Richard Wylkyns of Lighthorne 1556

In the Name of God Amen A.D.1556 The eighth day of March I Richard Wylkyns of Lighthorne husbandman being sick and in good & perfect mind make my this my Last Will and Testament as followeth

First I bequeath my soul to Almighty God and our blessed Lady and to all the holy company of heaven and my body to be buried within the churchyard of Lighthorne.

I bequeath unto the mother church of Worcester 2d.

Also I bequeath to **Richard Greenway** 10s.

To every one of my godchildren 8d.

The residue of my goods unbequeathed both movable and unmovable my body being honestly brought to the ground I give and bequeath unto **Julian** my wife whom I make my sole executrix.

And I make **John Smythe** and **John Burton** to be my supervisors to see this my last will truly performed.

To this witness **John Townside** & **John Myler** with many others.
