W.C.R.O. Will of Thomas Sale (of Lighthorne?) 1576

(The top of this will is missing, possibly half the will)

------Also in the hands of John Suffolk 42? --my other 15 sheep, and 20s.and all money in my coffer equally to be divided between the said 3 persons by equal portions as soon as they may conveniently receive them. Also I give to them 13s.4d. in my fathers hand which was given me at mine own fathers decease, and 3s. in John Genkyns hand to be divided as aforesaid. Also I will and charge the said parties, John, Richard and Agnes to pay & discharge all my other gifts & bequeasts (being not otherwise discharged) contained in this my last will, and also the charges of my funeral, and other payments whatsoever, equally to be borne of them three.

Item I give to John Sale my brother my lease and from him (if he chance to depart this life before my mother) to Richard Sale my brother, and in like manner from him to Agnes my sister if he depart before my mother.

Also I make John Sale my brother mine executor of this my Last Will and Testament, to do therein according to the true meaning thereof.

And the overseers of the same my very friends Leonard Smyth my (master?) and Thomas Mason the elder, and they to have for their pains 20d. a piece.

Witnesses present William Smart parson, Leonard Smyth, Richard Warwick, John Townsend and Thomas Mason.
