

**W.C.R.O. Will of Alis Raynolds of Lighthorne 1557.**

In the Name of God Amen. A.D. 1557. The 20th day of May, I Alis Raynolds of Lighthorne widow being sick in body but of good & perfect mind make this my Last Will and Testament as followeth. First I bequeath my soul to almighty god unto our blessed lady and to all the company of heaven and my body to be buried in the church yard of Lighthorne. Also I bequeath to the mother church of Worcester 2d. To the church of Lighthorne 12d. Also I will that 13s.8d. be distributed to the parishioners at the day of my burial.

Also to **John Richard & Alan** my sons either of them 13s.8d.

To **Richard Whitley** a land of wheat lying upon a furlong named Deadquene.

To **Elizabeth Burton** widow my servant two ewter

latters a coverlet & a sheet.

Also I will that all my rayment be equally divided betwixt my two daughters **Agnes & Margaret**.

The residue of my goods unbequeathed both movable & unmovable I bequeath to **Thomas** my son whom I make my sole executor.

Also I ordain **Richard Whitley & Thomas Mason** to be supervisors to see this my Last Will and Testament truly performed.

To this witness **John Townsend** and **Leonard Smyth** with others.

proved before us Master Hall etc. at Stratford the 18th August 1557.
