

**W.C.R.O. Will of John Greneway of Lighthorne 1557**

In the Name of God Amen. A.D. 1557. The 27th day of May, I John Greneway of Lighthorne husbandman being sick in body but of good & perfect mind make this my Last Will and Testament as followeth.

First I bequeath my soul to almighty god unto our blessed lady and to all the company of heaven and my body to be buried in the church yard of Lighthorne.

Also I bequeath to the mother church of Worcester 2d.

To the church of Lighthorne 4d.

To **Richard** my son £3 at the age of eighteen years.

To **Elnor** my daughter 40s. at the age of eighteen years, and them to be heirs to the other.

The residue of my goods both movable & unmovable my debts paid and my body brought to the earth I bequeath to **Agnes** my wife whom I make my sole executrix.

Also I ordain **John Randoll** & **John Suffolk** to be supervisors to see this my last will & testament truly performed. To this witness **John Knight** & **William Harbart** with others
