

W.C.R.O. Will of Richard Jeacocks of Lighthorne 1722.

In the Name of God Amen the eight day of January 1721/2 I Richard Jeacocks of Lighthorne in the county of Warwick yeoman being ill in body but of perfect memory make my Last Will and Testament as followeth. I give to my sister **Judith Jeacocks** all my goods chattels and cattle of what nature and kind soever after my just debts and funerals are paid and discharged whom I make sole executrix of this my Last Will and Testament. **Richard Jeacocks.**

No Probate notes attached to this document, but there is a separate Grant of administration which was allowed to **Judith Jeacocks** who was on oath to carry out the directions in this will. 13th day of August 1722.
